### Math Remote Work (Grades 5-8)

<b>Directions</b>	<p>In order to help you review what we've learned in math class this year, we've set up an account for you to access Khan Academy. Here is some helpful information on how to access your math work:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. You can find your username and password by clicking <a href="#">on this link</a> and going to the tab marked with your grade. You can also look at the document entitled "Intrepid Khan Academy Credentials". Names are listed in alphabetical order within advisory groups.</li><li>2. Once you find your username and password, you'll log into your account by clicking <a href="#">on this link</a> and clicking "Already have an account?" From there, you can enter your username and password. You can also go to <a href="https://khanacademy.org/signup">khanacademy.org/signup</a>.</li><li>3. From there, you'll be able to click on the links to begin specific lessons.</li><li>4. Your math teacher will be able to monitor your progress as you complete your lessons.</li><li>5. Your math teacher has added new lessons for the week of March 30th. These lessons are available today, March 25th, and we encourage you to begin them early, if possible.</li></ol> <p><b>To help you complete these assignments on time and keep your math brain sharp, please choose at least thirty minutes each day to work on your math assignments.</b></p>

<b>Directions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. We have moved the reading log online! You can access the updated version of the reading log by clicking on the following link: <a href="#">OA Reading Log</a></li><li>2. This week, you will choose two new prompts to respond to from the OA essay packet.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Remember that the packet contains four essay prompts in total (two which you used last week) and you should respond to the two prompts that you have not used.</li><li>● If you have access to a printer, you can print the pages and write your response in the packet.
